

<u>Tehama County CattleWomen</u> <u>Scholarship for Students with Ag Majors</u>

Complete the Tehama County CattleWomen's Agricultural Scholarship Application and Submit by May 15, 2022.

Criteria:

- 1. Must be a U. S. Citizen.
- 2: Must have been a resident of Tehama County at time of graduation and/or a graduate of a Tehama County High School.
- 3. Must be a full-time college sophomore, junior or senior or graduate student Fall 2022.
- 4. Applicant's Degree Objective must be in agriculture or ag related major.
- 5. Academic Transcripts must be enclosed with application. A cumulative G.PA. 2.5 or higher is preferred.
- 6. Autobiography must also include the Following:
 - a) Further Education and Career Goals.
 - b) Qualities of Good Character and Leadership Abilities.
- 7. Must Submit 2 Letters of Recommendation (to be included with application)
- 8. Please submit a photo with your application. If selected as a recipient, it may be published in local newspapers and media for congratulatory announcements and TCCW promotions.
- 9. Award Monies must be used exclusively for school expenses.
- 10. Interview with scholarship committee will be part of the selection process.
- 11. Enrollment and full-time student status must be verified by the college or university <u>before</u> the award will be funded.
