Complete the Tehama County CattleWomen's College Scholarship Application for Children of Tehama County Ranchers, Farmers or Agricultural Professionals and Submit by May 15, 2022.

Criteria:

- 1. Must be a U. S. Citizen.
- 2. Must have been a resident of Tehama County at time of graduation and/or a graduate of a Tehama County High School.
- 3. Must be a Full-time College Sophomore, Junior, Senior or Graduate Student Fall 2022.
- 4. Academic Transcripts must be included with application.
 - A cumulative G.PA. of 2.5 or higher is preferred.
- 5. Autobiography must <u>also</u> include the following:
 - a) How family is involved in agriculture.
 - b) Education and Career Goals and future support of Agriculture.
 - c) Qualities of Good Character and Leadership Abilities.
- 6. Must Submit 2 Letters of Recommendation (To Be Included In Application)
- 7. Please submit a photo with your application. If selected as a recipient, it may be published in local newspapers and media for congratulatory announcements and TCCW promotions.
- 8. Award Monies must be Used Exclusively for School Expenses.
- 9. Interview with Sponsor Scholarship Committee will be part of the Selection Process.
- 10. Enrollment and full-time student status must be verified by the college or university before the award will be funded.
