Agriculture Vocational Scholarship

2018 Scholarship Guidelines and Application

Award: Minimum One- \$1,000.00 Scholarship

Number of Awards: 1

(Additional Awards if Funding Available)

The **Tehama County CattleWomen** will award one-\$1,000.00 Scholarship (Additional awards to be awarded if funding is available) to a student(s) pursuing appropriate certification in a field related to, and supportive of agriculture. This includes, but is not limited to: 1) Heavy Equipment Operations; 2) Electronics; 3) Welding; 4) Diesel/ Farm Machinery Repair. **NOTE: Students pursuing a 4-Year degree are not eligible.**

Each recipient must be enrolled as a full-time student in an appropriate program starting the fall semester of the year in which the scholarship is awarded.

Applicants must be a student in good academic standing and have a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. Students who are currently enrolled in the program, or students graduating from high school are eligible to apply.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be:

- Tehama County Resident and/or a Tehama County High School Graduate.
- Enrolled as a full-time student.
- Enrolled for the fall semester of the year in which the scholarship is awarded.
- Pursuing an associate of applied science degree or certification in a trade related to agriculture as listed above.

Those receiving their high school credentials through General Education Development (GED) must be in the upper 50 percentile rank score compared to the population of high school seniors across the United States on a standardized high school equivalency exam.

All applicants must submit 1) a letter of recommendation from a school official (teacher, advisor, counselor, or administrator); 2) a letter of personal reference; 3) a letter of recommendation from an employer, shop advisor or work supervisor (if applicable); 4) and a copy of the high school transcript or GED certificate 5) a digital photo of him or herself.

Selection and Award of Scholarship

The stipend will be paid directly to the respective student's account at the Institution the student attends or will attend upon verified enrolment. The scholarship may be applied toward the cost of tuition, fees, books, tools and/or other needs associated with a student's education in the selected field.

Stipulations

Upon accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to remain enrolled on a full-time basis, attend classes regularly and maintain a satisfactory academic standing.

The recipient must allow their name to be published in local newspapers and media for Tehama County CattleWomen promotions.
