Subject Matter: Plein Air and Quick Draw compositions should be Red Bluff Bull and Gelding Sale related, such as, working dogs, working horses, around the barns and trade show activities

Supplies: Bring your own supplies. Be ready to paint/draw on location within the fairgrounds, in public view. The artist's canvas, paper, board, etc. must be initialed by Tracy, the contest coordinator.

Publicity: The Tehama County Cattlemen reserves the right to photograph any work in the show for publicity purposes.

Liability: Tehama County Cattlemen and Red Bluff Bull and Gelding Sale will not be responsible for damage or loss which may occur from any cause.
