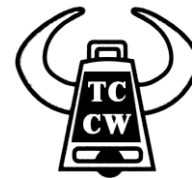




## **Tehama County CattleWomen** **Agriculture Vocational Scholarship**



### **2026 Scholarship Guidelines and Application**

The Tehama County CattleWomen will award one vocational scholarship (additional awards to be awarded if funding is available) to a student pursuing appropriate certification in a field related to, and supportive of agriculture. This includes but is not limited to: 1) Heavy Equipment Operations; 2) Electronics; 3) Welding; 4) Diesel/Farm Machinery Repair.

**NOTE: Students pursuing a 4-Year degree are not eligible for the vocational scholarship.**

Each recipient must be enrolled as a full-time student in an appropriate program starting the fall semester of the year in which the scholarship is awarded. Applicants must be a student in good academic standing and have a minimum GPA 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students who are currently enrolled in a vocational program, or students graduating from high school with plans to enter a vocational program are eligible to apply.

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

Applicants must be:

- Tehama County resident and/or a Tehama County High School graduate.
- Enrolled for the fall semester of the year in which the scholarship is awarded.
- Pursuing an associate of applied science degree or certification in a trade related to agriculture as listed above.

All applicants must submit

- A completed application
- 2 letters of recommendation
- A copy of their high school transcript or GED certificate
- An interview with the scholarship committee may be a part of the selection process
- A digital photo of him or herself; if selected as a recipient, it may be published in local newspapers and media for congratulatory announcements and TCCW promotions. Please email photo to [tccwinfo@gmail.com](mailto:tccwinfo@gmail.com).
